5. Glory be to God and to Him be praise. Glory be to **Allah** Almighty. I ask **Allah's** forgiveness (100x).
(after 100th time): I ask **Allah** Almighty's forgiveness from every sin and disobedience and from all that opposes the religion of Islam, from all that opposes the Law, from all that opposes the Path, from all that opposes Realisation, from all that opposes the Truth, from all that opposes firm intention, O most Merciful of the Merciful.

6. I ask **Allah** Almighty's forgiveness and turn to Him in repentance (100x).
(after 100th time): The repentance of a slave who has oppressed himself who neither has power over his death, nor his life, nor his resurrection.
O **Allah!** You are my Lord. There is no god but You. You have created me. I am Your slave and I hold fast to Your covenant and Your promise [as much as I am able]. I take refuge in You from the evil I have done, and testify that Your Grace is upon me, and profess my sin. Forgive me my sins, for there is no one who forgives (sins) except You, O **Allah!**
